2023 Year 9 Provisional Enrollment

Provisional Year 9 enrollment is now open. For provisional enrollment, parents are to bring child's original birth certificate and Annual Examination marks or letter of completion of Year 8 education from the Head Teacher. Parents will have to fill the provisional enrollment form at the school. Provisional enrollment will be processed by end of November with confirmation of enrollment notices sent to the parents/guardians by December. Filling and submitting of Provisional enrollment form does not guarantee enrollment of your child at the school. Complete documents need to be submitted to school upon confirmation notice has been received from the school in December.



Textbook Return

Parents/guardians are advised to ensure that their children return their textbooks that had been issued to them at the beginning of the year. All textbooks will be collected on the day of their exam paper (Annual Examination for Years 9-11 and FY12CE/FY13CE for Years 12&13). All lost textbooks will have to be replaced.

School Clearance

Parents/Guardians are advised that if you are seeking clearance of your child from the school, you need to ensure that your child returns all the textbooks issued to him/her.

Parent Teacher Interview

Considering that Year 12 & 13 have concluded their Annual Examination, parents/guardians are advised to make an appointment and visit the school to find out the progress of the child. There will be no separate day allocated for PTI as our focus is more on preparing our student for the exams. However, parents/guardians are encouraged to visit the school from 17/11/22.



E-Learning & School Website

E-Learning Platform for our students and school website is being developed to meet the demands of 21st Century Technology Enabled Teaching & Learning. This will be up and running by end of November. Through E-Learning, students will have the opportunity to stay connected with their teachers and students after school hours through discussion forums, short tests, quizzes, supplementary notes and resources that would enhance learning. Students will have unique ID and password to access E-Learning platforms while parents/guardians will have access to the school website to find out the activities of the school and their contribution to the school activities. News updates will be posted in the website and with a click of the button, parents/guardians will have information about the school. All you need to have is a smart phone and data to access our website. Link for the website will be communicated to all stakeholders in due course.



Channel of Communication

Parents and guardians are reminded to raise all issues of concern with the Head of School first before taking the matter to other authorities. Head of School will try to solve the issue and should it require intervention from higher authorizes, Head of School will refer them for clarification and appropriate action. HOS can be contacted via phone, email or by writing a letter.

School uniform/Rules

Parents/guardians are requested to support the school in maintaining good discipline amongst students at all times. All students should come in proper uniform as per the school rules till the end of 2022 academic year. Parents/guardians to ensure students are in proper attire when coming to school during external examinations.



Students' Arrival/Departure time during external exams

Arrival time for students will remain as per the school rules. It is advised that students are to be in school before time as papers for the first session would start at 9.00am. Students will be finishing first session of the paper after 12.10pm. Students will only be allowed to leave school if parents/guardians are coming to pick them from the school. Those parents/guardians that cannot make it during the day to pick their children, students will have to stay in school and will depart in the normal mode of transport. Second session of the paper ends at 5.10pm and it is mandatory for parents/guardians to make arrangement for pickup of the students after the paper. We seek full cooperation from parents/guardians to ensure students reach home safely after their second session papers.

Extra Classes/Saturday Classes

For any additional classes, parents/guardians will be communicated. If there are any planned extra classes by school, a consent form will be issued to your child which needs to be signed by you.

Community Outreach

As part of parental engagement, teachers will be engaging in home, village and settlement visits to talk to the parents and guardians regarding bringing improvement in student's performance at the school and working together on plans to meet the expectations of the school. Parents and guardians will be notified of any such planned visit. We hope to have good attendance from parents and guardians whenever such visit is made.



Role of Parents

- Prepare a conducive environment for children to study at home
- Avoid unnecessary *Talnoa* around the house that would distract your child's learning
- Ensure your child is at the study table by **7.00p.m** and studies for at least **2-3 hours** each evening.
- Provide balanced and healthy meals.
- Switch off the television/movies when your child is studying
- Ensure your child does not access mobile phones and other gadgets while studying as these would distract their attention.
- Avoid unnecessary gatherings at home as your child needs valuable learning time at home
- Continuously communicate with your children on morals and importance of studying.
